

The Pavilion of the Travelers Insurance Companies is a 65-ft-high, 160-ft-diameter dome, identifiable as the firm's corporate symbol—an opened red umbrella. Sixteen floodlights, pole-mounted four to a pole, light this red dome at night. Each floodlight contains a 5-kw G-64 150-hour lamp, operating at 3.78 kw to provide 1,470-hour life. Standard 125-volt lamps are operated at 105 volts to provide the longer life. A surrounding fountain-pool, with red, blue and amber lighting, lights underside of the dome. Liebfried, Inc. was the electrical contractor.



FOUR 15-FT-LONG luminaires, each containing four 5-kw floodlights and pole-mounted at 80 ft, light the 160-ft-diameter dome of the Travelers Insurance Companies Pavilion to an intensity of 25 foot candles. Photo at right shows one luminaire.
